Wildlife & Habitat Round Table (was Joint Non-consumptive Use)

- Wed once a month @ Parks and Wildlife building
- Director of Parks and Wildlife heads this so it would be good for us to be represented

PARC

- Ian will submit our chapter report to PARC for annual report by end of the week
- New Jr Co-chair needed before March meeting in Spokane; qualifications in letter
- Working Lands for wildlife Illinois, Indiana, Ohio turtles
- New position from PARC on how to share info for those seeking funding via CrowdFund or GoFundMe for projects; PARC receiving requests and wondering how to give grants without endorsing crowd source; disclaimer for PARC that they are not soliciting for the request, just sharing it and they have to get an approval from regional co-chairs. Not required of regional or state PARC, but we may want to do this if we ever get request for sharing grant fundraising site.
- Working Lands for Wildlife is a land use management program/project aimed at working with users of lands that are used for agricultural and energy development purposes to promote practices that protect the species diversity of these labs while they are being used. PARC partnered with this joint venture between NRCS (Natural Resource Conservation Service) and USFW by sponsoring an addition to the projects already under way by promoting Blanding's Turtle conservation in the Midwest. They got IL right away, but were looking for other states to partner with the program to expand the total contiguous lands of target habitat. Blanding's Turtle is at risk due to overuse of agricultural lands, and energy development interests. It's taken a few months to get OH and IN to join. NEPARC is emulating this project at a regional level to protect Spotted and Wood turtles. It's creating a mutually reinforcing justification for these kinds of projects. You might be familiar with Prairie Sage Grouse. I believe they were included under this umbrella.
